ENTRY OUALIFICATIONS/REOUIREMENTS

The minimum entry requirements for Higher National Diploma (HND) programmes are:

- a) The National Diploma (ND) in the relevant programme with a minimum of Lower Credit.
- b) 5 relevant Credits at SSCE or GCE of WAEC/NECO or NTC of NABTEB or equivalent obtained at not more than two sittings.
- c) One year post National Diploma (ND) working experience.
- d) Candidates with Pass ND may be considered for admission but will require a minimum of two years post qualification working experience.
- e) Candidates who obtained National Diploma from institutions other than Waziri Umaru Federal Polytechnic, Birnin Kebbi, should request their institutions to send in the transcript of their academic records to the Registrar, Waziri Umaru Federal Polytechnic, Birnin Kebbi.

2.0 NATIONAL DIPLOMA (ND) AND NIGERIA CERTIFICATE IN EDUCATION (NCE) PROGRAMMES

The Polytechnic also offers two-year National Diploma (ND) in all the above listed programmes and also in:

- i Computer Science
- ii Local Government Studies
- iii NCE Technical Education
- iv. NCE Business Education

ENTRY QUALIFICATIONS/REQUIREMENTS

Interested candidates should check the entry requirements for the programmes of their choice on the Admission Portal/Website of the Polytechnic. Candidates should note that ND admissions are done through the Joint Admissions and Matriculation Board (JAMB). However, prospective candidates are expected to submit their details for post UTME screening by filling the on-line application.

3.0 ONE-YEAR PRE-ND SCIENCE PROGRAMME

The School of Remedial Studies offers the Pre-ND Science programme to prepare candidates for admission into the full-time National Diploma programmes in Engineering, Environmental Studies and Applied Science. There is also the Pre-NCE programme in Technical Education and Business Education.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

The minimum entry requirements for Pre-ND and Pre-NCE programmes are the possession of a minimum of three (3) Credits and Two (2) Passes at SSCE of WAEC/NECO/NABTEB. Subjects passed must include English Language, Mathematics and any of the following: Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Agricultural Science and Geography obtained at not more than two sittings. The programme is strictly for candidates from the Educationally

Less Developed States (ELDS), which include: Adamawa, Bauchi, Bayelsa, Benue, Borno, Cross River, Ebonyi, Gombe, Jigawa, Kaduna, Kebbi, Kano, Katsina, Kogi, Kwara, Nassarawa, Niger, Plateau, Rivers, Sokoto, Taraba, Yobe and Zamfara.

4.0 METHOD OF APPLICATION

Prospective candidates should obtain transaction PIN from any branch of Zenith Bank Plc upon payment of Three Thousand Naira (N3,000.00) only.
